COVID-19 GUIDELINES

For the safe use of the Edgbaston Cricket Centre, please:

- 1. WEAR FACE COVERING WHERE NECESSARY**
- 2. SANITISE HANDS FREQUENTLY**
- 3. KEEP YOUR DISTANCE (2m)**

ARRIVAL

- Because there is no waiting area in the Cricket Centre you should try to arrive for your session no more than 15 minutes before the start time.
- Please remember to keep the usual 2m distance apart as you enter the main doors, we are operation a one-way system so you will need to leave the building via the fire exits which will be clearly marked.
- You will need to sanitise your hands in reception before entering the net area.
- You maybe asked to do a self-administer temperature check which must be recorded on the sheet provided.

TEST & TRACE

- The centre now operates with a QR code – if you have downloaded the NHS Test & trace App you can scan yourself in at reception as you enter the building.
- If you are not able to do this – then please visit our website and complete the Test & Trace form ([edgbaston.com](https://www.edgbaston.com) follow the link to cricket centre)
- For teams and organised group hire, the person booking the event will need to take responsibility to provide contact details for the rest of the group.

MOVEMENT AROUND THE CENTRE

- You should only sit if necessary, in the seats made available for safe social distancing apart.
- You must sanitise your hands before entering the toilets and follow the wash your hands process.
- If you have any rubbish, please put this in the bins provided.

NET AREA USE

- You should keep your distance as much as possible and refrain from any shouting
- You will be asked to have regular sanitising breaks during the session
- You must not share equipment such as bats, pads, gloves, helmets
- Only six players will be allowed on any lane (2 batters & 4 bowlers). Please note it is vitally important that you stay in that bubble of 6 players for the duration of the session (this is for batting and fielding drills)
- No saliva must be used on the balls used at anytime
- There will be markers behind the wickets at the bowler's end, which indicate the 2m distance while waiting for your turn to bowl.

EQUIPMENT

- All players must try and minimise the amount of equipment they bring into the centre which will assist with space around the centre.

VIEWING GALLERY

- The viewing gallery is not in use at present; therefore, all visitors must wait in their cars or outside the building.

SEATING

- There is limited seating along the outside of the netting area, therefore parents are asked to minimise their stay (for junior coaching sessions 5 to 8-years-old). Parents must wear a mask if they feel the need to wait.

LEAVING/EXIT

- You must take all your belongings with you on leaving the centre, anything left behind will not be kept.
- You must leave via the fire exit doors which are clearly marked.

COACHES

- All coaches must wear a visor or mask when working in too closer proximity to players.
- They must maintain and control Social Distancing as much as possible during the session.
- They must instigate regular sanitising breaks throughout the session.

TOILETS

- If you use the toilets, you must sanitise hands before entry and please wash your hands after use. You should sanitise before re-entering the nets again.

RUBBISH DIEPOSAL

- Please put all rubbish in the bins provided inside and outside the building or take these home with you.
